

About DESIP

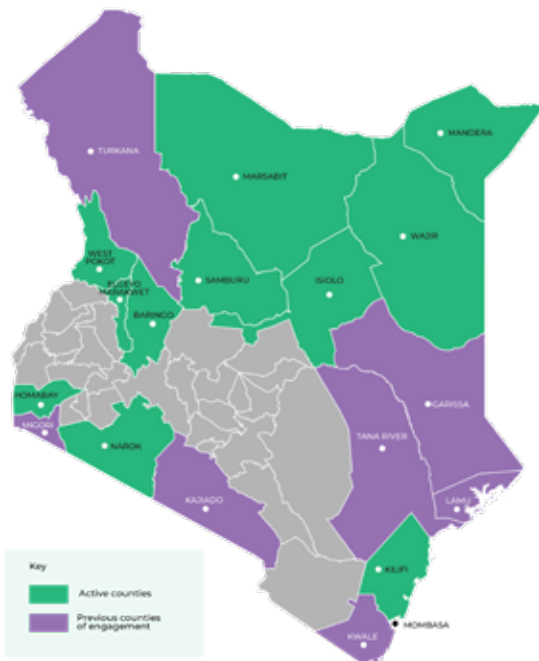
Delivering Equitable and Sustainable Increases in Family Planning programme, abbreviated DESIP, is a 6-year, UK Aid funded programme focusing on improving Reproductive Health in Kenya with focus on Family Planning in low (<45%) Modern Contraceptive Prevalence rate (mCPR) counties in line with Kenya 'Vision 2030'. Project period June 2019 to March 2025.

Programme Goal

The goal of the programme is to ensure that women and girls can safely plan their pregnancies and improve their SRHR, particularly the young rural, and marginalized, with programme impact contributing to reduced maternal Mortality, Newborn, and Child mortality, and increased mCPR in Kenya.

Geographical Scope

The programme focus at inception was in 19 counties. As a result of funding cuts, the scope was reduced to 12 counties in year three as shown in the map below.



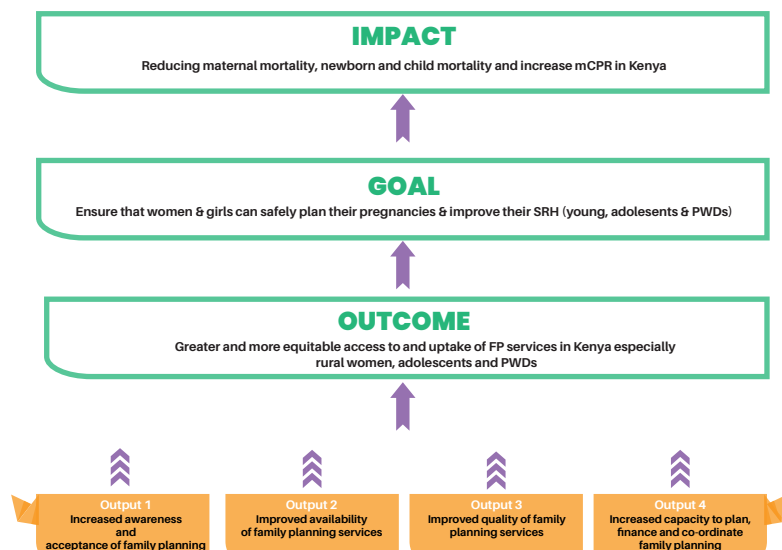
Target Beneficiaries

The target population for the DESIP programme is women of reproductive health with special focus on:

- o Adolescents
- o Poor Women (<\$1.90 per day)
- o Persons with Disability (PWD)

Implementing Partners

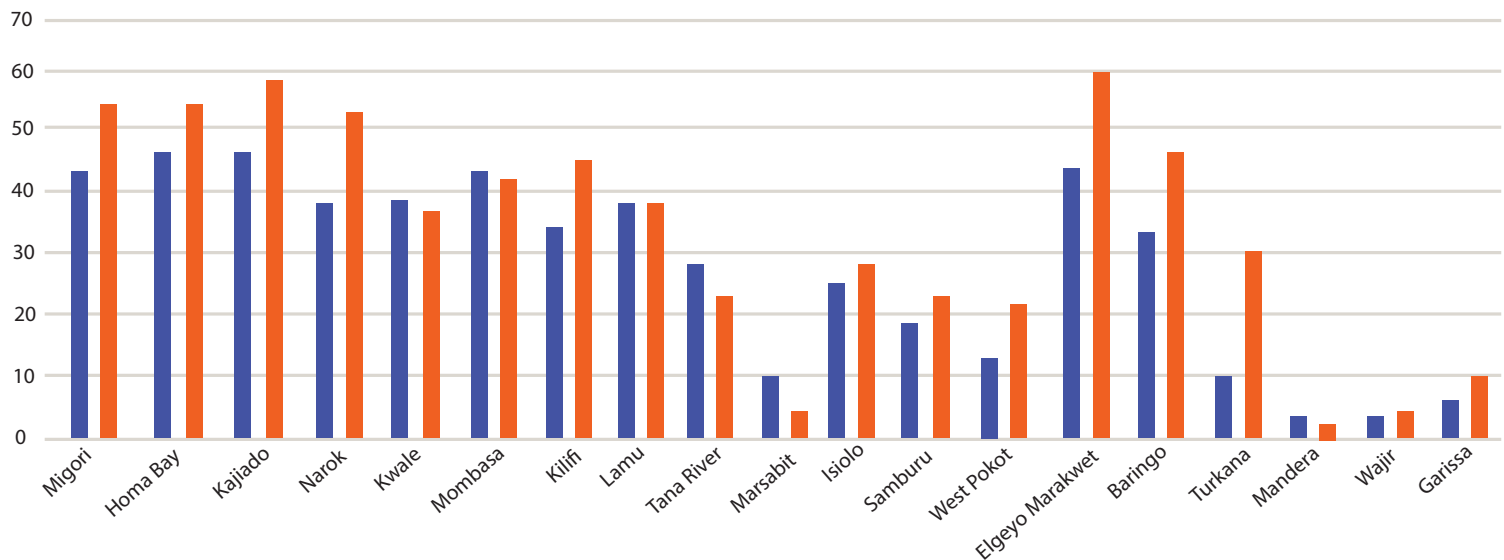
DESIP is implemented by a consortium led by Population Services Kenya (PS Kenya), in partnership with Options Consultancy Services, Faith to Action Network, Health Rights International, Voluntary Service Overseas Kenya, Population Services International and AMREF Kenya.

Expected Results

The programme aims to deliver 322,000 additional family planning users, 2.3 million couple years of protection (CYP), and 2,221 maternal deaths averted by 2024.

Programme Impact

The programme has also achieved the following as at December 2022

- o Total unintended pregnancies averted- 1,439,092
- o Maternal deaths averted- 3,761
- o Unsafe abortions averted- 323,293
- o DALYs averted- 2,182,508
- o Couple Years of Protection (CYPs)- 3,006,974
- o Additional family planning users- 306,228
