Binti Shupavu - A360's flagship ASRHR program in Kenya - works alongside girls, their communities and governments to support girls to access SRH services they want, and need. Led by PSI and implemented by PSI Kenya, Binti Shupavu places her story and needs first, engaging influencers in her community to create an enabling environment for her to use her voice to choose the life, and family, that she wants.

OUR IMPACT

BINTI SHUPAVU IS BEING IMPLEMENTED IN 4 COUNTIES WITH SOME OF THE HIGHEST DISEASE BURDEN ON MATTERS GIRLS AND CONTRACEPTION.

Since the start of implementation, we have reached over 176,770 adolescents through Binti Shupavu Clinics, 37,347 mothers of adolescents, 13,051 husbands of adolescents and 38,737 community influencers through Binti Shupavu Stories. The Binti Shupavu skills classes have graduated over 2,500 adolescent girls with various skills ranging from hair dressing, mat making, soap making among other skills across the implementing counties.

Binti Shupavu's programming creates an enabling environment for young women to learn about contraception and use their voice to choose the lives, and families, that they want.



Binti Shupavu Clinics are the entry point for adolescent girls - offering them a safe space to connect with their peers, learn about contraception and share their own stories of growth.
